E.	Approval of Resolution # 1213-18 Education Protection Account Funds						
	Pursuant to Article XIII, Section 36 of the California Constitution, school districts, county offices of education, and community college districts are required to determine how the moneys received from the Education Protection Account (EPA) are spent in the school of schools within its jurisdiction, provided that the governing board makes the spending determinations in an open session of a public meeting. The language in the constitutional amendment requires that funds shall not be used for the salaries and benefits of administrators or any other administrative costs. Adjusted for 2012-13 P2 Revenue Limit, McFarland Unified School District is expected to receive approximately \$3,855,562 in EPA funds These funds will be used to pay for Instructional Salaries and Benefits that directly affect our students. The district will annually post on their website an accounting of how much money was received from EPA and how that money was spent. Approval is requested.
