B. Approval of Declaration of Need for Fully Qualified Educators

The district is committed to hiring the most qualified teachers for our students. Implementation of the Local Control Funding (LCFF) and the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) require that each district's LCAP public hearing be held in advance and at a separate meeting from the adoption meeting. The intent of the LCAP hearing is to allow for public comment and recommendations regarding the specific actions and expenditures proposed to be included in the LCAP and budget. Further, the regulations require that the public hearing for the budget be held at the same meeting as the public hearing for the LCAP. This requires a change to the process of holding the budget public hearing and adoption at the same meeting as most districts have used in the past and requires an earlier preparation of the budget and/or an additional board meeting arranged. Districts should consider and plan to adhere to these new requirements in realization that the timing may be further complicated by the timing of the Governor's May Revise and the potential late release of the SACS software.
