He also reported on a couple of minor glitches that were quickly resolved. Mr. Hopper also gave kudos to: Mr. Navarro at MHS regarding the AP Spanish Students, to MHS for the AVID Self Study approval by the AVID Center, and to two students who were recipients of gold medals at a national cross country competition this summer. Mr. Hopper also mentioned a Press Release

regarding the need for "Access to Trained Health Care Professionals". He added due to this need Bakersfield College in partnership with McFarland Learning Center will offer the Certified Nurse Assistant with Home Health Component Courses at the McFarland Learning Center.
