Parents of eligible children can choose from the list of state-approved providers. When parents have made their selection, the District must then contract with that provider to deliver services. The law requires that supplemental education service providers adhere to high-quality, research-based instruction. The law states that a provider must continue to provide SES to eligible students until the end of the school year in which those services were first received. Many of our students are in need of supplemental services and this approval will allow us to provide tutoring for 240 students. The selection of students is determined by need.
