	Approval of this item approves the contract and gives authorization to apply to E-rate for reimbursement of the cost of upgrading the network at the Learning Center. The Learning Center has received the networking equipment from the other sites in the past because due to the rules the Learning Center would never get funded. With the changes in Erate this past year, the Learning Center now qualifies for a funding of \$18,000. The upgrade will finish the upgrade of the network at all sites. Erate will pay a percentage of the cost for upgrading the network. They now have a cap on the dollar amount based on the enrollment of the school. The Learning Center currently has a cap of \$18,000 to pay for their network upgrade.
