The State Allocation Board (SAB), at its January 2016 meeting, has authorized school districts to adjust Level 1 developer fees for inflation to a maximum of \$3.48 (from \$3.36) per square foot for residential construction and \$0.56 (from \$0.54) per square foot for commercial/industrial construction. It is the goal of the administration and Board of Education to maximize the fees collected under the law to assist in developing school facilities to adequately house the student population. A Public Hearing must be held to consider the adoption of school facilities fees on new development pursuant to Education Code Section 17620 and Government Code Section 65995.

After a Public Hearing is held, the Board of Trustees is requested to consider the adoption of school facilities fees on new development pursuant to Education Code Section 17620 and Government Code Section 65995. The Notice was published on 4/22/16.
