Superintendent's Report:

Superintendent McCurtis gave the attendance report.

He first stated that he had been invited on Monday to Browning Road Elementary School where there were 60 young boys and girls that through the efforts of Mr. Ortega and Mr. Arguello would otherwise not had a Christmas.
